The Wesley Institute Library provides access to a range of electronic databases, which can be used to help with your research by providing references to journal or newspaper articles, and other sources such as reports, conference proceedings, book reviews, etc.

These databases are password protected and available via the Internet. In order to comply with licensing and copyright regulations, please tick on your *Application for Library Membership Form* which databases you would like access to.

In signing this declaration you agree to abide by the conditions of use. On receipt of your emailed application which has been verified by the ACOM Registrar, you will receive by return email the appropriate username and passwords for the required databases.

ATLA RELIGION DATABASE

The *ATLA Religion Database* provides information on topics such as biblical studies, world religions, church history, and religion in social issues. It contains more than 1.4 million bibliographic records covering the research literature of religion in over 60 languages. It includes more than 416,000 article citations from more than 1500 journals, (571 currently indexed), more than 210,000 essay citations from over 157,000 multi-author works, more than 432,000 book review citations. Coverage spans from 1949 to the present. This is an essential resource for researchers and students in theology as well as in the social sciences, history and the humanities.

RELIGION AND PHILOSOPHY COLLECTION (RPC)

This database provides extensive coverage of such topics as world religions, major denominations, biblical studies, religious history, epistemology, political philosophy, philosophy of language, moral philosophy and the history of philosophy. *Religion and Philosophy Collection* offers more than **300 full text journals**, including more than 250 peer-reviewed titles, making it an essential tool for researchers and students of theology and philosophical studies.

This database is ideal for use in postgraduate, postdoctoral and faculty research and the database includes over 300 full-text titles.
